

Daisy – Examination System

November, 2017

Daisy classes are held every Saturday per our yearly schedule. Classes start at 2pm with Zohrain prayers led by Dr. Maulana Hussain Nawab. Class duration is 90 minutes and are followed by light refreshments.

Attendance:

Regular attendance and punctuality is essential to superior learning. We at Daisy therefore, emphasize on regular attendance.

We use a school software package to record student attendance in our Daisy system. Per Daisy rules if you are late by 10 minutes you are marked as late.

At Daisy, to promote excellent attendance we award a bonus of 100 marks to every student with perfect attendance at the year end. The bonus marks are added to your exam results to determine class positions for the prize distribution ceremony.

However, sloppy attendance has its downside as well. To allow for unavoidable circumstances like being sick or travelling we allow 4 absents and 4 late joining free for a full Daisy year. For every late after 4 late-arrivals 6 marks are deducted from attendance bonus of 100 marks. Similarly for every absence after the allowed 4 absents 10 marks are deducted from the yearly attendance bonus marks.

For example a student who was absent for 4 days and late for 4 days in a Daisy year no deduction is made and he/she is awarded full 100 bonus marks. In another case if a student was absent for 6 days he/she will get only 80 bonus marks. (As, $6 - 4 = 2$, $2 \times 10 = 20$, out of $100 - 20 = 80$) For detailed understanding you may want to talk to your teacher or principal.

Term Exams.

We hold three term exams in a Daisy year named as Term-1, Term-2 and final or Term-3 exam. The term exams are always pre-announced so parents should note down exam dates. A student could be excused for an exam once in a year time but a make-up exam must be pre-arranged for a missed exam. A missed exam means 0 marks which will ruin a student's class position at the year end. No make-up exams are allowed for the final or Term-3 exam.

Quizzes are regularly held during classes. Quiz marks are NOT added to final marks. Similarly homework and other class assignment marks are NOT added to the final marks.

Every Daisy exam carries 100 marks. For class positions and trophies we first add all (term-1, term-2 and term-3) obtained marks and attendance bonus marks into one number and take an average divided by 4. All the computed-average marks are sorted for each grade from highest to lowest and then we pickup top 3 for the class positions (1st, 2nd and 3rd) for every class. If there are two or more contenders for the same position all the contenders for the position are awarded trophies.
